Mana Wāhine roopū update

Mana Wāhine Kaupapa Inquiry Hearing One - Kerikeri 3-5 February 2021

- Judge Reeves has confirmed the schedule for the witnesses to present their evidence at Kerikeri on 3-5 February 2021. There will be 21 witnesses providing evidence at the Hearing. The first witnesses to present evidence are two of the original Wai 381 claimants that filed the first claim for this Inquiry.
- In response to the recent COVID-19 situation in Northland, Judge Reeves has directed that the hearing will proceed in Northland unless the circumstances change.
- If the COVID-19 situation escalates and/or official advice changes, then she will look to either
 postpone the hearing or conduct the hearing via Zoom. Judge Reeves stated that neither
 situation is ideal, but the safety of all participants and the wider community is paramount.
- Judge Reeves has also provided an opportunity for parties to seek leave to appear via Zoom, rather than in person. This needs to be submitted by claimant counsel by 12 pm,
 Friday 29 January 2021.
- Judge Reeves will communicate as soon as possible if there are any changes to the current arrangements.
- We will provide you with talking points on Monday 1 February should you be approached by media to comment on this Hearing.
