Commentary on the release of the Household Labour Force Survey (HLFS)

The release of the Stats NZ HLFS results for the December 2020 quarter has led to more discussion in the media on the gender and ethnic disparity in the employment and unemployment figures. While overall the figures were encouraging for economic recovery, there are still gender gaps, and impacts for those groups who may have already been facing challenges in the labour market, including Pacific and Māori women, and young workers. The Ministry will analyse the data further to inform its policy advice.

Mana Wāhine roopū update

Tūāpapa hearing 3-5 February 2021

Members of the joint roopū are attending the first Tūāpapa hearing in Kerikeri this week. You have media points and background as needed for any queries you may receive on the hearing.

Although the focus of the Tūāpapa hearings is to enable claimant witnesses to give their evidence,

Minister Mahuta, Minister Allen, and Jan Logie MP, who are in Northland for Waitangi and other Crown events, have called into the hearing. Minister Davidson is also expected to call in.

Some witnesses spoke of the origins of Te Ohu Whakatupu (the previous Māori policy unit at Manatū Wāhine Ministry for Women), noting their disappointment at the unit's demise. Some of the research claimants have carried out will be useful as the Ministry concludes work on the history of this unit.
