OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

I refer to your official information request of 19 January 2023 for:

Under the Official Information Act 1982, I wish to request all information regarding the total amount spent on consultants—per consultancy firm—for each of the last six years.

Please note that the annual reviews do not provide the total amount spent on consultants, per consultancy firm.

The Manatū Wāhine – Ministry for Women Annual Review contains an accurate and complete summary of the Ministry's total expenditure on consultants and contractors, broken down by firm.

We follow the following guidance set by the Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission, where departments are able to consolidate contracts below \$10,000. This is reflected in our Annual Review.

Furthermore, where the supplier is a private individual, the names are withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the Act, in order to protect the privacy of natural persons.

As such, your request is refused under section 18(d) of the Act, as the information is already publicly available.
