I refer to your official information request of 27 June 2024 for:

- Please supply, under the Official Information Act, dates on which any advice has been given to the Minister for Women, the Minister for Pharmac, the Minister of Health or any associate Minister of those portfolios, on the impact on women of issues with estrogen supply. In each case, I would like to know if the advice has been supplied proactively by the Ministry or at the request of the Minister.

Manatū Wāhine Ministry for Women has not provided advice to the Minister for Women, Health, Pharmac or associated Ministers regarding the estrogen supply in New Zealand.
