OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

I refer to your official information request of 8 October for:

- The number of directly employed staff currently working at the Ministry for Women.
- The number of directly employed staff and their positions who earn less than \$27.80 per hour (excluding all allowances or overtime rates).

Manatū Wāhine Ministry for Women (the Ministry) submits its workforce data to the Public Service Commission (PSC) on a quarterly basis. In our quarter ending 30 September submission to the PSC, we reported 39 staff directly employed by the Ministry.

The Ministry does not employ any staff members earning less than 27.80 per hour (excluding all allowances and overtime).
