NACEW appointments and reappointments process underway

As you are aware, the terms of the members of the National Advisory Council (NACEW) on the Employment of Women are due to end on 18 December 2025. The Ministry for Women is supporting you with the process to both reappoint and appoint new members to NACEW.


NACEW members have been notified of the reappointment process and the Ministry intends to start publicly advertising NACEW vacancies from Monday 7 July through to Thursday 31 July 2025. We will provide your office with the draft advertisement for your review and feedback as well as the email to seek nominations from your Caucus colleagues and coalition partners.

The Ministry has engaged with the Chair of NACEW on this process, and she is aware of the next steps and timings.
