OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

I refer to your official information request of 21 January 2025 for:

- In the month of July 2024
- how many phone calls/txts/emails did your ceo/head of agency send/receive after 6pm (please break down by sent/received)
- how many of those were sent/received after 10pm
- how many days during this month did they respond to a message after 6pm
- how many txts/emails/phone calls did they make on a Saturday or Sunday

The Ministry for Women Chief Executive works to ensure that the majority of communication with staff occurs during standard working hours. However, due to varying priorities, work programmes, and event schedules, some communication may be sent or received outside of these hours. There is no expectation for staff to respond or work outside of their usual working hours.

We have identified fourteen emails in scope of your request, a majority of which were with external stakeholders. Seven emails were sent, and seven emails were received by the Chief Executive after 6pm during the month of July 2024. No emails were sent or received after 10pm.
